How to organize?

- /drivers/net/<tech>/
 - Appletalk
 - Arcnet
 - Ethernet (NEW)
 - Tokenring
 - WAN
 - Wireless

How to handle legacy?

- `/drivers/net/legacy` ??
- What to do with old drivers or drivers not frequently used?
- **SOLUTION:** Do not use “legacy”, no reason to move old drivers or drivers not used into a legacy directory

RESOLUTION

- Use `/drivers/net/<technology>` as the desired structure
- Move `/drivers/net/<arch>` into appropriate `<technology>` directory
- Move ethernet drivers into `/drivers/net/ethernet`
- Cleanup Kconfig to reflect directory structure
- Create `/drivers/net/sw` for vlan, 8021q, bonding, bridging, etc drivers
